- Dha'eef because of missing narrator(s)
 - Mu'allaq
 - Mursal
 - Mu'dal
 - Munqati'
 - Mudallas
 - Mursal Khafi

- Dha'eef because of weakness in the narrator:
 - Maudu' (ignored and abandoned)
 - Matrouk
 - Munkar
 - Ma'rouf
 - Mu'allal
 - Contradicting the authentic narrators
 - Mudraj
 - Maqloub
 - Al mazeed fi Muttasil Alasaaneed (the addition in the well connected chain of narrators)
 - Al Mud-tarib
 - Al Musahhaf

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- Al shaath and Al mahfouz
 - Al Jahalah bir-Rawi (the unknown narrator)
 - Al Bid'ah
 - Poor memorization
